






INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

INLIGHT Flame Retardant Clothing are **IS 15748:2022 / EN ISO 11612:2015** certified. Special care and instructions are to be followed for their proper usages which are as under,

1. These garments are made from ISI / EN tested fabric which are tested to specific performance parameters.
2. These are **NOT** fire, heat, molten material proof garments.
3. Level of resistance depend on duration of exposure.
4. Possibility exists of heat transfer depending on exposure.
5. Nylon / Polyester based garments should not worn inside.
6. Life of garments depend on use and exposure.
7. Use should be decided after proper hazard evolution.
8. Special storage conditions and washing & cleaning instructions are to be followed which are as under,
 - 8.1. Store in dry ventilated and shaded area.
 - 8.2. Avoid moisture contact.
 - 8.3. Should be clean regularly depending on use.
 - 8.4. Zip the garment and turn it inside out, then machine wash or hand wash it separately with mild detergent.
 - 8.5. Do not bleach or use fabric softener, use standard detergent only.
 - 8.6. Do not use brush or scrub while washing.
 - 8.7. Do not dry clean the garment.
 - 8.8. Tumble dry at low level or dry in shade.
 - 8.9. Inside out medium heat set iron only.
9. Misuse of flame retardant clothing can life threatening. Correct hazard and type garment should be used in accordance to the requirement.
10. There are working environment and conditions specified for use of flame retardant clothing, limiting its use for concerned hazard and type.
