INFORMATION FOR INSURANCE INQUIRIES

- ISO Protection Class 6/6x (6x = the old 9)
- 2 Stations (Town of Mancos, Cedar Mesa Subdivision-base of Mesa Verde National Park)
- All Volunteer
- Mancos Fire Protection District covers 45 square miles
- Average Response Time to (most) Rural Residences – 10-15 minutes
- Equipment:
 - Engines/Pumpers – 3 Type I Engines 1)1500 /1000 Foam Class A; 2)1250/1000 Foam Class A; 3)1000/750
 - Tankers – 2: 1)1650; gl. 2) 1,800 gl.
 - Brush Trucks: 5 (with foam suppression tanks and/or water tanks)

Notes:

- Most rural residences do not have hydrants in close proximity
- Many (not all) rural residences have dry hydrants, seasonal ditches, ponds, reservoirs, river and/or creek
- Most of the county roads within the District are gravel
- Initial Wildfire Attack/Structure Protection everywhere in the District
- We have mutual aid agreements with Dolores Fire Protection District and Cortez Fire Protection District for additional tankers if needed.
