## **Laughlin Water Service**

LEDC continues to engage with the LVVWD/BBWD on water service for Laughlin. Recently, the concept of using Fort Mojave Development Act funds for a Loan to the Big Bend Water District to construct one tank has been raised. Issue is, will that allow for additional building in the township and how many dwelling units will that support. The LEDC will continue to engage with all parties to come to a reasonable path forward around the water service issue.

## **LEDC Annual Meeting**

## **Laughlin Flood Control**

The Regional Flood Control District has not yet finalized the detention basin and diversion dike and other immediate impact items for the area of Bruce Woodbury and Thomas Edison. The LEDC continues to communicate with the CCRFCD on timing for this project.

## **Laughlin Water Reclamation Service**

The Clark County Water Reclamation District has a need to upgrade the #2 Lift Station at W Casino Dr and the Force Main from that Lift Station. Easement agreements have been made with stipulation on project timing and funding. It appears there is a path forward for this project. The LEDC will continue to engage with the CCWRD on this project.

## **Representation of LEDC on FMDA fund Capital Plan**

A proposal has been made by the LTAB to form a committee, outside of the LTAB, to review the FMDA fund and its use. A Capital Plan has been proposed to be created. The LEDC will make every effort to be represented on this committee.

## **LEDC support of Local Students**

The LEDC awarded three scholarships in 2025 to graduating seniors from LHS. The LEDC sponsored two LHS students that participated in the Mohave Health Coalition this year. We also supported a group of students in attending the Wizard Of Oz show at the sphere in Las Vegas.
