BluGold Guaranteed Transfer Program (BGTP)

BGTP participants are full-time university students, gaining both high school and university credit for the courses they take.

- ➢ 4-6 university classes per semester
- > 24-36 university credits per year

Courses taken at UWEC-BC "replace" required high school courses at NCA. Thus, a student may meet the graduation requirement of high school biology by taking Biology 105 (Freshman Year Biology) at UWEC-BC.

Students do not complete "twice as much work," they simply receive both university AND high school credit for university classes.

Students entering grades 11 & 12 are eligible to apply for the BGTP.

- > There are 25 openings each year, with re-enrolling applicants receiving first placement.
- For those who would like to be a part of the BGTP both years, we recommend they enroll at NCA in 9th or 10th grade to be best positioned for consideration.

Students who successfully participate in the BGTP are guaranteed transfer admission to UW - Eau Claire's <u>main</u> <u>campus</u>, a direct pathway to <u>UW - Madison</u>!

BluGold Guaranteed Transfer Program (BGTP)

BGTP students attend classes at the <u>University of</u> <u>Wisconsin - Eau Claire: Barron County Campus</u>

➢ 45 minutes away from North Cedar Academy

- Students are brought to UWEC:BC in the morning (8am) and picked up in the afternoon (4pm) so that they are able to join extra-curricular activities or study, and eat dinner on NCA campus.
- If a student does not have a university class scheduled during a specific day of the week, they study in the North Cedar Academy academic building and assist in their favorite NCA classes as teacher assistants and peer-tutors.



BGTP Admission Considerations

To enter the UWEC/NCA Bluegold Guaranteed Transfer Program at NCA, and be guaranteed admission to the University of Wisconsin – Eau Claire, students must:

- Enter NCA in grades 9-12 as a boarding student
- Preference is given to students who enter NCA in grades 9 or 10
- Earn a minimum 3.0 GPA in grades 10 or 11 in NCA classes
- Have no Major School Rule Violations at NCA
- Earn a minimum of 24 credits in UWEC-BC classes while enrolled at NCA in grades 11 or 12
- Earn a minimum 2.0 GPA in UWEC-BC classes
- Score a minimum of 70 on the TOEFL (exceptions may apply based on student interview results)
- Be recommended to the UWEC-BC admission Committee by the NCA Senior Leadership Team
