Non-Trivial Pursuit Game Instructions

Pre-Shabbos Preparation

- Print free Game Boards from the website or from the weekly downloads. One board per player. There are 30 unique boards available, each with a randomly placed set of 25 numbers.
- 2. Laminate the boards if you play weekly so that you only have to print one time.
- 3. Prepare soup nuts, chocolate chips or other small treats.

How to Play

- 1. Each player is given a copy of the Answers Sheet and a Game Board.
- 2. Each player covers the board during the game with soup nuts, choc chips or other treats.
- 3. The game leader asks each player in turn one questions from the Question & Answer Sheet. The questions are asked in the order they are written. The number to the left is the answer number on the players answer sheet. When the questions are asked in order you will never lose track of which numbers you asked previously during the game.
- 4. Help the younger children find the answers to avoid frustration.
- 5. The player looks through the answers. He/she should call out the number and read the correct Torah Pasuk to the other players.
- 6. If all agree that this is the correct answer and the correct number then ALL players put a "treat" on that number on their own Game Board.
- 7. The game is won by the first person that matches the winning pattern. Winning patterns may be a single line in any direction for a quick game with small children or preferably the full set of outside numbers for a regular game.
- 8. On Shabbos all players should eat the treats used to cover the board for participating in the game.
