 - 25:42 "For they are My servants whom I have taken out of the land of Egypt..."

 - 25:46 "...you shall work with them forever..."

- 10 What happens to the non-Jewish slave after the Jewish slave owner dies?
 - 25:46 "You shall hold them as a heritage for your children after you..."
