- 5 How does the Torah define the time to count between each Yovel or Jubilee year?
25:8 "...seven cycles of sabbatical years..."

- 6 Hashem says that in the Jubilee year, what will each slave owner do?
25:10 "...you shall return each man to his ancestral heritage..."

- 16 Hashem promises that if we keep the mitzvot properly, what good will be with us?
25:18 "...then you shall dwell securely on the land."

- 3 What does it mean that we will dwell securely on the land?
25:19 "The land will give its fruit and you will eat your fill..."

- 4 If someone asks what will we eat in the seventh year, what does Hashem promise?
25:21 "I will ordain my blessing for you in the sixth year..."
