11 What did Hashem tell Moshe to write down about the Jews?

33:2 "Moshe wrote their goings forth according to their journeys ..."

9 Where did the Jews journey forth from on the day after the Pesach-offering in Mitzrayim?

33:3 "They journeyed from Rameses..."

1 The Jews journeyed from Marah and came to Elim. How many springs of water were there?

33:9 "... in Elim were twelve springs of water and seventy date palms ..."

4 What were the people lacking when they encamped in Rephidim?

33:14 "...and there was no water there for the people to drink."

33:38 "Aaron the Kohen went up to Mount Hor at the word of Hashem and died there..."

23 How old was Aaron when he died?

33:39 "Aaron was one hundred and twenty-three years old..."

33:55 "... pins in your eyes and thorns in your sides ..."

5 How did Hashem describe the size of the Land and what is outside the land?

34:2 "... the inheritance of Canaan according to its borders."

34:3 "... from the desert of Zin to the border of Edom"

35:3 "...and their open spaces of the cities..."

- 7 How many cities were given to the Levites to dwell in?
35:7 "... to them you shall give forty-eight cities."

35:11 "... cities of refuge shall they be for you ..."

35:12 "...so that the murderer will not die until he stands before the assembly of judgement."

- 12 How many cities of refuge were there?
35:14 "Three cities shall you set on the other side of the Jordan and three cities shall you set in the land..."

35:22 "But if with suddenness, without enmity, did he push him ... he was not his enemy..."

35:25 "... and the assembly shall return him to his city of refuge ..."

- 14 What happens to an accidental murder after the death of the Kohen Gadol?
35:28 "...the murderer shall return to the land of his possession."
