Cul de Sac landscaping project: We are getting quotes for the best deal. Major issue is the construction debris that must be removed before any planting of trees/grasses. Cost of the required bobcat to remove the debris is \$1,300.

We had a meeting with the Mayor regarding water pressure issues. Water pressure is generated by the height of the water tower. We are at 49lbs.

Standard pressure is 40 to 80 lbs so we are within the minimum.

There are plans for a second, higher tower. Construction will start in about six months.

There is also a grant for a test well that could mitigate our need to buy water from Artesian.

The gravel road by the storage lot will be restored and no expense to us
