

Presentation Evening Policy



The Petersfield Town Juniors annual Presentation Day has been a tradition for many years. Its purpose is to reward the young players with personal achievements as well as making them feel special and proud.

Awards

Depending on the age groups the awards presented by the Manager and Assistant Manager are:-

- Players Player (the players choose their player of the year).
- Most Improved Player (which player has improved the most during the season).
- Player of the Year (taking in to account the season, who is the man of the match).
- Penalty Shoot-Out Winner (winner of the team competition).
- Medallion for all teams U11's.

Purchasing Awards

The Executive Committee authorise the purchase of the awards and medallions via the Kit and Equipment Manager.

Other Team Awards

Managers can provide extra awards, but this must not be given out at the Presentation Day. This should be kept within the team and funded by the team, to avoid disappointment from other teams and remove any perceived preferential treatment.

Golden Boot Awards

The club does not support any type of “top goal scorer” award, since these types of award does not involve the whole team.

Penalty Shoot-out Winners

Towards the end of the season, and before the Presentation Day, the team managers for teams U9 and upwards must organise a penalty shootout competition where by all the players can compete (including the goalie). The winner will receive the Penalty Shootout Trophy at the Presentation Day.

The winner and runners up for the U11 and over will be entered in to the clubs Penalty Shoot-Out, where the teams compete at the Maureen Tarling Memorial Cup.

Best Dressed Team Competition

Each team is measured by a panel of guests that will judge who they think is the best dressed team. The Team will be presented with the “Best Dressed Team” cup, at the end of the presentation.

Presentation Evening

There are two sittings;

- 16:00 – 18:00 (U6, U7, U8, U9, U10, U11)
- 19:00 – 21:00 (U12, U13, U14, U15, U16, U18)

The Chairman is normally the person who hosts the evening, and invites each team along with their Manager and Assistant Manager. The team is introduced, and a short speech about the team’s successes and sometimes its difficulties is provided by one of the Managers. Then each Award is presented.

U16 Farewell Trophy

The U16 team members will receive a special trophy to mark the closure of their career with the Petersfield Town Juniors FC. The Managers will be presented with a gift as a thank you for their help and commitment to team, the club, and the community.
