Streaming is the process that allows the movement of players between teams according to their level and rate of development.

The club has introduced streaming in order to give players the opportunity to play in a team at the appropriate level, best suited to their ability. This will give them the best opportunity to develop and realise their potential. We recognise that streaming can be a contentious issue for players, parents and managers, with differences of opinion. The welfare and development of every child is the priority at all times.

The club will ask the under-10 team managers to oversee the streaming process for their age group before the new season starts in September. The managers will keep the process under periodic review, usually at the end of each season.
