NASH (non-alcoholic steatohepatitis) is a progressive and chronic liver disease caused by an excess of fat and inflammation in the liver. Over time, NASH can lead to serious health problems like fibrosis (scarring) of the liver and permanent liver damage. Many people with NASH have no or few symptoms and remain undiagnosed. Today, there are no approved drugs to stop or reverse NASH with liver fibrosis.

Inventiva is conducting a clinical trial to evaluate if an oral investigational drug called lanifibranor is safe and effective in treating people who have NASH.
