Tree Stand Policy

- 1. Written permission is required from the BC when using a semi-permanent tree stand or blind.
- 2. BC is defining a "semi-permanent tree stand or blind" as any tree stand or blind that is left on BC property for more than 24 hours. i.e. If you take your stand or blind out with you each time, no permit is needed. If you intend to leave a ladder stand out all season, a permit is required.
- 3. Only tree stands which do not damage trees or bark may be used.
- 4. All tree stands must be tagged with owner ID per PGC Regulations.
- 5. This permit must be in possession of the hunter when hunting from a permitted tree stand or blind.
- 6. Tree stands may be left for the deer season but <u>must be removed from the tree</u> and from the property by January 20th the following year.
- 7. No tree stand may be installed before 2 weeks before the opening of archery season.
- 8. BC is not responsible for injury to the user.
- 9. BC is not responsible for loss or damage to tree stands left on our property.
- 10. Any tree stand found damaging trees will be removed.
- 11. Any tree stand not removed by the deadline will be removed.
