

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS KINGSBURY COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

The Kingsbury County Board of County Commissioners met Friday, October 9, 2020 at 2:00 P.M. in the County Commissioners meeting room in the Courthouse with Commissioners Roger Walls, Steve Spilde, Shelley Nelson attending via Zoom. Delmer Wolkow was present. Chairman Walls presided. Gregg Gass, State's Attorney, Lonny Palmlund, Maintenance, and Elaine Blachford joined the meeting.

APPROVE AGENDA

Spilde moved and Wolkow seconded to approve the agenda. All present voting aye - 4, nay - 0, motion carried.

BURN BAN

Chairman Walls informed the Board that Cindy Bau, Emergency Management, had discussed the implementing of a burn ban for Kingsbury County. Five of the Six Fire Chiefs agreed with initiating a burn ban.

Nelson moved and Spilde seconded to place a burn ban in effect until further notice. All present voting aye - 4, nay - 0, motion carried.

OPEN DISCUSSION

Jennifer Barnard, Auditor, informed the Board she had been in contact with Judy Wolkow and Vikki Irvin regarding the temporary door monitor position that had been posting in the paper. Both were able to start right away.

Palmlund informed the Board on the status of preparing the building for reopening to the public.

It was the consensus of the Board to open the courthouse on Tuesday, October 13, 2020, with the following precautions in place: masks will be required, door monitors hired, plexiglass in place and hand sanitizer available. The door monitors will screen those entering the building including taking of temperatures. The only information recorded will be names, phone numbers and destinations for contact tracing.

The Board adjourned to Tuesday, October 20, 2020 at 8:30 A.M.
