Kazmerzak provided an overview of updates on highway matters from Dave Sorenson, Highway Superintendent.

Striping Agreement

Motion by Lundquist and seconded by Walls for Chairman Kazmerzak to sign the Striping Agreement with the State of SD for 78 miles of Kingsbury County roads. All present voting aye. Motion carried.

AUDITOR

Steffensen presented SDPAA Endorsement forms for signature.

Motion by Lee and seconded by Spilde for Chairman Kazmerzak to sign the SDPAA Endorsement forms.

WEED BOARD

Tanya Flegel, Weed Supervisor, met with the Board to discuss the Weed Board pickup that is stored at the highway department. Flegel informed the Board that she would bring the matter of transferring the pickup to the highway before the Weed Board at their next meeting.

MAINTENANCE

Lonny Palmlund, Maintenance, updated the Board on maintenance matters.

Palmlund provided information to the Board on the sidewalk and parking improvement projects. The Board requested Palmlund work with Lundquist and provide a cost comparison on the project before moving forward.

Palmlund informed the Board the County was awarded a matching grant of up to \$20,000.00 from the Deadwood Fund through the South Dakota State Historical Society for the tuckpointing project. Palmlund requested a motion for Kazmerzak to sign the Covenant agreement and other necessary paperwork for the grant. It was the consensus of the Board for Chairman Kazmerzak to sign the agreement.

Palmlund presented estimates from Barret's flooring for replacing the carpet in the lobbies and the stairs. The following estimates were provided: Carpet- \$8,499; Rubber treads and vinyl for stairs and entry-\$2,926 and Annex vinyl \$2,400. The Board requested Palmlund get estimates for carpet tiles and luxury vinyl. No action was taken.

AUDITOR

Steffensen updated the Board with information on the possibility of offering health insurance to part time employees. No action was taken.

Steffensen informed the Board she was working on providing information to Risty Benefits to get a quote on other health insurance providers and would update them when the quote is completed.

Kazmerzak left the meeting at 10:04 A.M. Lee, Vice Chairman presided.

REGISTER OF DEEDS Caryn Hojer, Register of Deeds, provided information to the Board on Cyber Security programs offered by Infotech and SDPAA for their review.
