Vaccination is a safe, highly effective, and easy way to help keep people healthy.



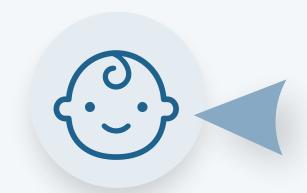
Before Pregnancy

Vaccination Save Lives!

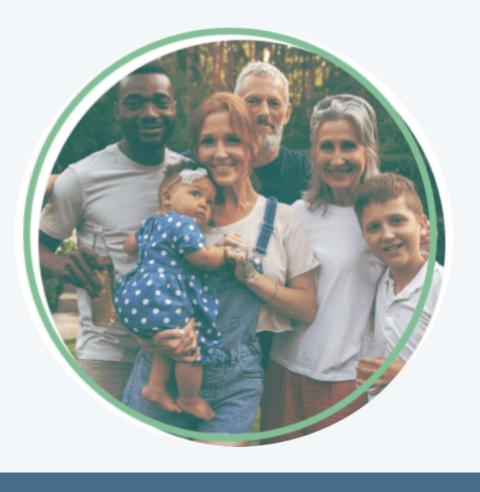
Vaccines Shield Against Illness.
