Relating to the Use of Electronic Voting Methods

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors have a responsibility to establish, adopt, and amend policies and procedures, for the management and operation of the common interest of members or the conduct of business and affairs of the Association; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors desires an efficient, cost-saving method for voting, that do not conflict with the governing documents or law, for amendment changes, election of officers, and assessment increases by secret ballot, have adopted the method of electronic voting by use of electronically transmitted mail (e-mail) or electronic voting software; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors seek alternative options for achieving a higher number of property owners to participate in the election of the Board, as well as, voting to approve or disapprove changes in the governing documents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors hereby adopts electronic voting by use of electronically transmitted mail (e-mail) or electronic voting software.
