Dave Olson

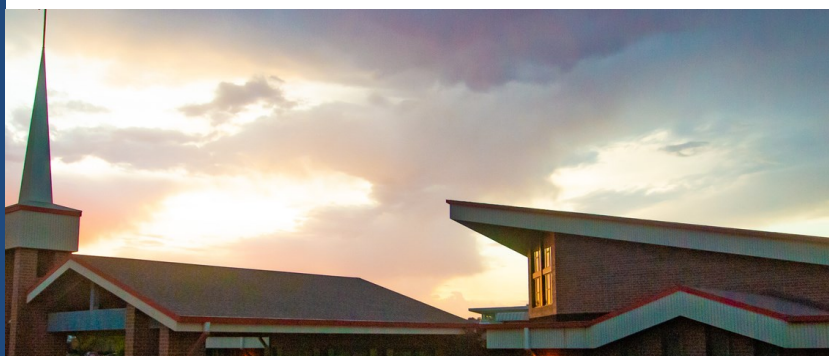
