### 2021 BUDGET MESSAGE

AltaColorado Metropolitan District No. 1 is a quasi-municipal corporation organized and operated pursuant to provisions set forth in the Colorado Special District Act. The District was established to supply the necessary services of water, streets, parks & recreation, safety protection, sanitary sewer, and mosquito control.

The District has no employees and all operations and administrative functions are contracted.

The following budget is prepared on the modified accrual basis of accounting, which is consistent with the basis of accounting used in presenting the District's financial statements.

### **2021 BUDGET STRATEGY**

The District's strategy in preparing the budget is to strive to provide the type of public-purpose facilities desired by the property owners and residents of the District in the most economic manner possible. The General Fund provides the operations and maintenance for the District and pays the associated general and administrative expenses. The primary source of funds for the District, at this time, is from developer advances.

That the budget as submitted, amended, and summarized by fund, hereby is approved and adopted as the budget of the AltaColorado Metropolitan District No.1 for the year stated above, as adjusted for immaterial changes in the final certified assessed value of the District as certified by the county assessor and corresponding adjustments resulting from such changes to the assessed value. In the event there are material changes to the assessed value then a subsequent meeting of the Board shall be called to consider such changes. Furthermore, to the extent capital or significant operating expenditures forecasted for the current year are anticipated to be extended into the following year, the expenditures and offsetting change in the budgeted beginning fund balance shall be updated to reflect management's best estimate at the time the budget is to be filed with the Colorado Division of Local Affairs.
- Section 2. That the budget hereby approved and adopted shall be certified by any officer or the District Administrator of the District and made a part of the public records of the District.

# Office of the State Auditor — Local Government Division - Exemption Form Electronic Signatures Policy and Procedure

### **Policy - Requirements**

The Office of the State Auditor Local Government Audit Division may accept an electronic submission of an application for exemption from audit that includes governing board signatures obtained through a program such as Docusign or Echosign. Required elements and safeguards are as follows:

- The preparer of the application is responsible for obtaining board signatures that comply with the requirement in Section 29-1-604 (3), C.R.S., that states the application shall be personally reviewed, approved, and signed by a majority of the members of the governing body.
- The application must be accompanied by the signature history document created by the electronic signature software. The signature history document must show when the document was created and when the document was emailed to the various parties, and include the dates the individual board members signed the document. The signature history must also show the individuals' email addresses and IP address.
- Office of the State Auditor staff will not coordinate obtaining signatures.

The application for exemption from audit form created by our office includes a section for governing body approval. Local governing boards note their approval and submit the application through one of the following three methods:

- 1) Submit the application in hard copy via the US Mail including original signatures.
- 2) Submit the application electronically via email and either,
- a. Include a copy of an adopted resolution that documents formal approval by the Board, or
- b. Include electronic signatures obtained through a software program such as Docusign or Echosign in accordance with the requirements noted above.
