Call to Order A Regular Meeting of the Board of Directors of the Haymeadow

Non-Potable Water Services to Single

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Family Homes

Mr. Hood reported that Water line breaks have been an issue and have created a sink hole on Sylvan Lake Rd. The Town didn't make it a requirement to offer non-potable water to single family homes. Mr. Hood will obtain a cost for replacement of the non-potable water system to the single family homes for consideration by the Board at the next meeting.

Ground Engineering Estimate

Mr. Hood reported that one proposal for soils engineering was submitted by Ground Engineering and he reviewed the details with the Board. Upon motion duly made and seconded it was unanimously

RESOLVED to approve the Ground Engineering materials testing and inspection services proposal.

Review of RMF 1 and 2 Bids Received 360

360 Civil and Nottingham construction submitted bids. Nottingham left off the Bond amount. The low bidder is Nottingham, even with the added cost of the bond. There was a review of the differences in the two bids. Mr. Greher reported that shallow utilities need to paid for by the developer rather than the District, that funds for payment of the contract need to be in place prior to letting the contract and that the Board will need to approve the Notice of Award and the form of the construction contract. Mr. Cohen reported that a letter of credit for the full cost of the construction contract is in place. Upon motion duly made and seconded it was unanimously

RESOLVED to accept the Nottingham RMF1 and 2 Utilities and Infrastructure bids with the removal of the shallow utilities from the District's scope of work, with the construction contract to be reviewed by District counsel and ratified at the next Board meeting and to authorize any Board member to sign the Notice of Award.
