Dear Zephyr Christian Family,

I always find it encouraging when archaeology discovers things that prove or help explain the Bible. Here are several interesting things that were uncovered by archaeologists in the last few months:

They discovered, in an ancient Philistine temple, the remnants of hallucinogenic plants. We believed, from ancient writings, that part of the worship of false gods included mind-altering substances, but now we have unmistakable evidence. Isn't it wonderful that our God doesn't ask us to set aside reason or clear thinking to know Him, but that He actually wants us to be in our best frame of mind to come to Him and understand Him?

The earliest ship ever discovered in the deep seas was found 56-miles off the coast of Israel. The 3,300-year-old boat itself is about 43-feet long. Scholars are saying that this discovery completely changes the understanding of ancient sailors and their abilities. The hull of the boat contains hundreds of two handled storage jars used to transport anything from grain to wine to oil.

Up until this past year, we did not have any contemporaneous evidence for the Kingdom of David. We had evidence that looked back and claimed that there was a Kingdom of David, but nothing from the time of that kingdom. However, in the last year they have found pieces of a monument from that time period and, when pieced together, they reference the Kingdom of David.

This is a little bit of a cheat, as it was originally discovered in 2010 but was then packaged for later investigation, only to be rediscovered in an office and then evaluated. What they found was an ancient earring. It was found in an archaeological dig from the time of Solomon. What is interesting is that the earring is Phoenician, and scholars believe it is evidence of what is recorded in 1 Kings 5 of Hiram, King of Tyre, sending workers and servants to Solomon when Solomon became king of Israel.

To be clear, we do not believe the Bible BECAUSE of these evidences...we believe the Bible because it is the Word of God. And whenever history, science, or archaeology makes a discovery it always confirms what the Bible teaches. So, while these evidences might cause frustration for the skeptics, they should only affirm what we already know and believe.
