2020 Summer Camp Expectations (COVID19)

Precautions that Foxmeade Farm will be taking:

- 3 handwashing stations (bathroom and hoses, equipped with soap and paper towels)
- Hand washing after each activity
- Hand sanitizer available
- Cleaning of common areas throughout the day, such as bathroom and outdoor activity tables
- Cleaning of riding equipment and supplies
- Social distancing when possible: when handling and riding the horses, a staff member may need to be close by to maintain control of the horse as your child learns
- Staff will self-monitor for symptoms each day prior to arrival
- Maximum of 8 campers allowed per week

Guidelines for parents: We ask parents to help by...

- If possible, purchasing a horseback riding helmet for your child. Unfortunately, bike helmets do not meet safety standards.
 - Check out: Southern States, Myrna's Boots and Bits, Dover Saddlery, SmartPak, and Champion Saddlery
- Taking your child's temperature every morning before bringing them to camp and assess them for any symptoms of illness
- Sending lunch and drinks in an insulated lunch box or cooler so that we can keep personal items separate
- Parents remaining in the car at arrival/pick up to limit the number of people out on the property
- Wearing of masks will be optional due to extreme heat and that we are fortunate to be outside most of the day
- Please remind your children that social distancing, handwashing and COVID19 precautions still apply at Foxmeade, even though it is an exciting outdoor space
- If child shows any symptoms of illness, parents will keep their child at home and there will be no refund
