

ORDINANCE 2020-015

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE V OF THE TOWN OF KINGSTON
SPRINGS ZONING ORDINANCE**

WHEREAS, the Town of Kingston Springs Board of Commissioners has previously adopted its comprehensive zoning ordinance known as Ordinance No. 84-005, as amended (here in “Zoning Ordinance”); and

WHEREAS, the Regional Municipal Planning Commission has requested that Article V of the Zoning Ordinance be amended to include the addition of a new Zoning District classified as Transitional Mixed-Use Planned Unit Development (TMU-PUD) District and has recommended same for consideration and adoption by the Town of Kingston Springs Board of Commissioners after public notice, hearing, and second and final reading

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF KINGSTON SPRINGS, TENNESSEE, THAT Article V of the Town of Kingston Springs Zoning Ordinance shall be amended to include a new Section 5.200 - Transitional Mixed-Use Planned Unit Development (TMU-PUD) District, the provisions of which shall be as set forth on the attached Exhibit hereto.

This Ordinance shall take effect the later of the date that is 15 days after its passage or upon publication of this Ordinance or its caption, the public welfare demanding it.
