

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING TITLE 15, SECTIONS 15-101 THROUGH 15-124, SECTIONS 15-301 THROUGH 15-304, SECTIONS 15-401 THROUGH 15-405, SECTIONS 15-501 THROUGH 15-510, AND SECTION 15-601 OF THE TOWN OF KINGSTON SPRINGS MUNICIPAL CODE AND ADOPTING BY REFERENCE CERTAIN STATE TRAFFIC STATUTES

WHEREAS, the Town of Kingston Springs Board of Commissioners desires to adopt by reference those certain state traffic offenses, registration requirements and rules of the road codified in state law; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated § 16-18-302 allows municipalities to adopt state laws by reference provided that only Class C misdemeanors may be adopted by municipalities and enforced as municipal ordinance violations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town of Kingston Springs that:

- 1) Title 15, Sections 15-101 through 15-124, Sections 15-301 through 15-304, Sections 15-401 through 15-405, Sections 15-501 through 15-510, and Section 15-601 of the Town of Kingston Springs Municipal Code are repealed in their entirety.
- 2) The following provision is added as a new Title 15, Section 15-126 of the Town of Kingston Springs Municipal Code:

15-126. Adoption of state traffic statutes. Pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated § 16-18-302, the Town of Kingston Springs adopts by reference as if fully set forth in this section those traffic statutes codified in Tennessee Code Annotated §§55-8-101 through 55-8-131, §§55-8-133 through 55-8-191, §55-8-193, §§55-9-401 through 55-9-408, §§55-9-601 through 55-9-606, §55-4-101, §§55-4-103 through 55-4-128, §§55-4-130 through 55-4-131, §§55-4-135 through 55-4-138, and §55-50-351.

This Ordinance shall take effect the later of the date that is 15 days after its passage or upon publication of this Ordinance or its caption, the public welfare demanding it.
