United Community Action Program, Inc., along with other Community Actions, have been celebrating many achievements these past few years. Community Actions nationwide turned 60 in 2024. In 2025 Head Start Programs across the United States also celebrated turning 60.

United Community Action Program, Inc., a private nonprofit, operates 20 Head Start/Early Head Starts in 15 towns and 8 counties of Oklahoma, and so our reach is wide into the lives of children, families, and communities. Along with Head Starts' 60<sup>th</sup> year, UCAP's transportation program Cimarron Public Transit System (CPTS) reached its 25<sup>th</sup> year in 2025. Transportation, as we all know, is essential for everyone in Oklahoma, and our CPTS program provides Ride to Work, Senior Citizen Transportation, Nutrition Rides, Medical Rides, and rides open to the public connecting citizens to fulfill vital needs. Since United Community Action's incorporation in 1969 and growing now to include 450 employees, UCAP has worked towards making communities better through our Housing, Family and Community Services, Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP), and Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) programs. The asset of our workforce and tax contribution to the economy reaches farther than the initial impact.

This year in the 2025 United Community Action Program, Inc., Annual Report, you will see faces and numbers of some of the work of UCAP in action. Our programs touch all ages from birth to seniors for better self-sufficiency. As one of seventeen Community Actions in Oklahoma, the work together compounds even more.
