

In February 2024 C&C Cattle Company owner, Colton Courtney was searching for the missing ingredient for the C&C Cattle Company genetic recipe that would create the complete Texas Longhorn. While scrolling on Facebook, he stumbled upon a young 3 year old bull owned by Bond Longhorns of Saylorsburg, PA. This bull looked awesome in every way and might just be that missing ingredient to our secret TL recipe. Sit back, relax and enjoy the story about this awesome bull.



In 2018, Justin Henry a veteran breeder from Falling Waters, West Virginia bred and raised this young bull named, HH Never Forget. Sired by Cherokee by Cowboy Tuff Chex, the longest horned sire in the breed (\$165,000), out of a daughter of Touchdown of RM called, RM Awesome Pat, bred by the one and only Red McCombs. He traced back to some of the best genetics in the TL industry at the time and still some today. Those included Cowboy Tuff Chex, Cowboy Chex, BL Rio Catchit, Cherrypicker, Tabasco, Touchdown of RM, Super Bowl, Unlimited, Farlap Chex, and Tari Graves FM49, just to name a few. He has great young horn development and growth and will mature into a well over 80" sire.



A few years later John King of Port Royal, PA purchased HH Never Forget and was using him on his core brood cow herd. John used him for 4 years, then sold him to Randy Murray of New Age Cattle Company, also known as the Burton-Stockton Ranches herd. About a year later he was then sold again to where he resides at the Silver T Longhorn Ranch of Dallas, TX, owned by Kurt Twining a veteran breeder in the TL industry. On 5/21/2023 he measured 84.25" TTT. HH Never Forget is the sire of HH Pentagon.



As a 3 year old heifer, just after weaning her first calf HH Faith sold at the 2021 G&G Fall Classic for \$9500 in Culpepper, VA. She was bred and raised by Justin Henry, sired by Fifty Fifty BCB out of a daughter of JP Rio Grande. Just the same as HH Never Forget. Everyone knew that her pedigree would back her up 100% and she soon would knock everyone's socks off as a mature cow. She was also purchased by Kurt Twining from the G&G sale.



As HH Faith matured, she soon proved everyone right! We believe she may be the very best daughter of Fifty Fifty BCB. Her mother, Lake Country Lindsey, was sired by the late, great, JP Rio Grande who sired many great cattle in the TL industry and still does today. On 4/3/2024 she measured in at a whopping 95.0" TTT, and is on the right track to make 100" very soon. Now

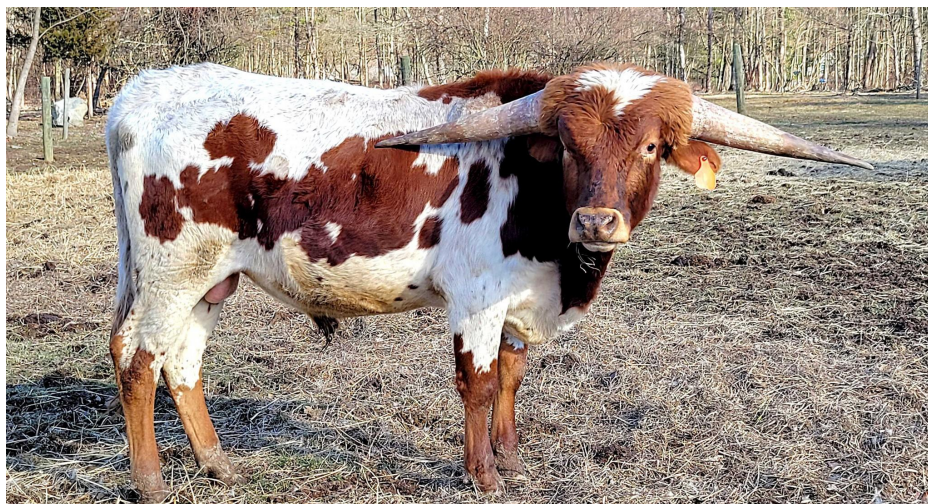
with Kurt owning both Pentagon's sire and dam, he could possibly produce another great TL with the same mating that created Pentagon.



Now, let's backtrack a little bit here. March 2, 2021 a bull calf was born to HH Faith out of the young promising sire HH Never Forget. As you can see from this photo, he is an exact replica of his sire and has that same early horn shape and growth. This was a great sign for a young bull who could possibly become a herd sire, and a great one!



As an early yearling HH Pentagon was consigned as a Sub Lot in the 2022 Northeast Texas Longhorn Association Sale, and was purchased out of the sale by Cathy Bond of Bond Longhorns. But little did she know what a special young bull he was when she placed her final bid. Here is Pentagon Fall of his yearling year at the Bond's ranch, just enjoying the warm Pennsylvania sunshine.



Spring of his 2nd year he was still showing great horn growth. They were still growing in the perfect direction, he was getting bigger by the day. 3 months after this photo was taken he measured a whopping 66" TTT just after his 2nd birthday. This was a great sign for him to be on the right track to soon become something awesome. The Bonds have already selected some of their best cows to be bred with him for excellent results in Spring/Summer of 2024.



One year later, the cows he was placed with the previous Summer are now starting to show signs of calving and the anxious waiting was now becoming unbearable. This was when C&C Cattle Company noticed him. The Bonds posted an opportunity and we jumped on it. He would soon become the main Herd Sire of the core C&C herd. As his calves started to appear, both the Bonds and the team at C&C noticed how consistent they were. They were colorful, had great conformation, size and substance and soon they were noticed to have awesome early horn development, within a few months. We were excited to get Pentagon here and get him on a few select cows and heifers for test breeding on the C&C herd.



It soon became the end of July and Pentagon was on his way to C&C Cattle Company. He arrived August 1st and first touched the rich New York soil and went right on the cow herd that was selected for him. We were excited to get him here. He is believed to be the best TL bull to ever step foot at C&C Cattle Company.



Joel & Rebecca Miner were trusted to haul this special bull from the Bond's ranch to C&C Cattle Company. They did an excellent job doing so. Later that day Pentagon was released from the bull pens and turned onto his cows. A special photographer was hired and took several great shots of him. He is so easy to photograph.



He has since met his neighbor in the next pasture, Wait Till Dark who is here on vacation from Barberry Farms of Sewickley, PA. They share a few choice bellows and then get back to work. They are well behaved and know what their duties are.



HH Pentagon was happy to see another set of good cows to share the rest of the Summer with. He measured a whopping 83.0" TTT on July 30th 2024 and is on the path to 90". The Bond/Courtney partnership has since been formed and we have decided to share this awesome bull's genetics with the rest of the industry. Fall of 2024 we will be collecting a small amount of conventional semen on him and offering it to other serious breeders for a \$45/straw introductory price with no minimum.
