# Meeting of Board of Directors MEETING MINUTES

## November 6th 2024

This meeting was called to order by Don Kidd at 6:30 pm.

#### **MINUTES:**

Jerry Halter made a motion to approve the minutes for the October 16<sup>th</sup> 2024 Board Meeting. The motion was seconded by Christy Hall- Scheufele. The Minutes were unanimously approved. The motion was carried.

#### FINANCIAL REPORT:

Everyone present looked over the financial reports for October 2024.

- General Fund had a SAIF Non-Dispersing (Buy Back) Claim expense, and we paid for Lotus Media Digital Advertising for the months of October and November.
- We received both our August and September FEMA Reimbursements.
- Had to pay up front for FEMA covered items, pending reimburse from the Grant
- Business as usual

\*Tax deposits (without interest) totaled \$1,176.22 for month of October 2024. Of this, \$879.45 was for the General Fund, and \$296.77 was for the Debt Service Fund.

Total expenses for the month of October were \$53,929.28, including:

- \$28,124.72 paid from the General Fund, including:
  - o \$7,766.00 Lotus Media Digital Advertising
  - \$2,400 SAIF Non-Dispersing (Buy Back) Claim
- \$8,274.00 paid from the Building Construction Fund
  - \$7,875 for Kunert Electric for our LED Light conversion
- \$46,369.84 paid from the Wildfire Readiness Fund, for CWRR grant expenses
  - 5 \$13,500 for Arbor View
  - o \$21,300 for Cowboy Tree
  - o \$3,900 Trees/Bush + Us (New Vendor)

We used \$7,875 towards our LED Light Upgrade throughout the office, and we will see the last \$32,950.87 in early November. The \$32,950.87 was used to cover building repairs, maintenance etc that were not Grant Expensed.
