Behavior Policies 2018 Kansas Lions Band at Friends University

NOTE – Dr. Taylor has no doubt that students in the Kansas Lions Band can abide by these policies. If you cannot meet these expectations, <u>DO NOT</u> come to the Lions Band. Final decisions of rule/guideline violation and consequence will be administered by State/International Band Committee Chair (Lion Shari Neidhardt), and Dr. John W. Taylor (Friends University).

Students in violation of these Behavior Policies:

- * Will be immediately removed from the State/International Band program.
- Parents/guardians will be notified.
- * Parents will immediately take the student home.
- * Staff members will enforce these policies with "Zero Tolerance"
- 1. No alcohol, tobacco, non-prescription medications, or other drugs.
- 2. No weapons (includes pocket knives, martial art, or other dangerous items).
- 3. No fireworks (of any size, shape, or type).
- 4. Offensive language, intolerant behavior, and disrespect of staff (such as talking back or rolling of the eyes) will NOT be tolerated.
- 5. No physical or verbal confrontations will be tolerated.
- 6. Students will not leave the dorm area other than for scheduled practices, events, and meals unless escorted by an adult staff member.
- 7. Students will follow dorm floor policies and stay in their assigned rooms after lights out.
- 8. Students will adhere to Friends University and Newman University policies as directed.
- 9. If students drive themselves to Lions Band camp, they will be required to turn in their transportation keys to the staff during initial check-in.
- 10. Clothing must be appropriate. Shirts may not be sleeveless, must cover the stomach and may not have questionable pictures or words. Shorts/pants/skirts may not be worn low, and shorts/skirts must be within 3" of the knee. If you have a question whether a clothing item is appropriate, do not bring it. If a clothing item is deemed inappropriate by the staff, the student will meet with Dr. Taylor, then be sent to his/her dorm room to change.
