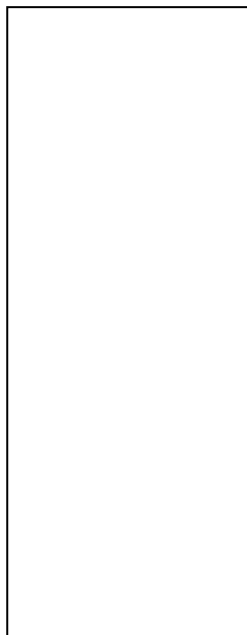

OUR GREATEST NEEDS ARE:

FOOD NEEDS: Cereal, Cereal Bars, Granola Bars, Oatmeal, Pancake Mix, Pancake Syrup, Applesauce, Canned Vegetables, Canned Beans (Baked, Black, Chili, & Refried), Canned Meats (Chicken, Salmon, Sardines, Tuna, etc.), Rice or Pasta Sides, Ramen Noodles, Tuna & Hamburger Helper, Pasta, Mac & Cheese, Canned Pasta Sauce (no glass jars), Tomato Sauce, Diced Tomatoes, Salsa, Box Potatoes, Peanut Butter, Jelly, Condiments (Ketchup, Mayo, Mustard, BBQ Sauce, & Salad Dressings), Small Bottles Cooking Oil, and Microwave Popcorn.

JOB POSITIONS OPEN

VOLUNTEER COORDINATOR / PANTRY ASSISTANT

Part-time position responsible for coordination of volunteers, assists with pantry operations, office tasks, and special projects.

Works Monday, Wednesday, and Friday 9:15 am—3:15 pm.

Main duties include recruitment, training, scheduling, and supervision of pantry volunteers. This individual will also compile volunteer reports and submit monthly to the Executive Director, collect and input client data, assist with donations, and complete routine office duties.

CLOTHING PANTRY COORDINATOR

Part-time position responsible for coordination of day-to-day clothing pantry operations, office tasks, and special projects.

Works Monday, Wednesday, and Friday 10:30 am—3:30 pm.

Main duties include supervising and organizing the intake and display of clothing donations as well as supervision of the distribution of items to clients. This individual will also train and supervise the volunteers assisting in the clothing pantry and submit monthly reports to the Executive Director.
