

Crispy Chickpeas



1 can of Chickpeas (Garbanzo Beans)
2 Tablespoons Coconut Oil

Flavor Options Below Salt and Pepper

Cheesy Flavor: 2 Tablespoons Nutritional Yeast Chili Lime: 2 Teaspoons Chili Powder & Zest of 1 lime

Rosemary & Garlic: 2 Teaspoons of both Garlic Powder & Rosemary Cinnamon Sugar: 2 Teaspoons of Cinnamon & 2 Tablespoons of Sugar

1. Preheat oven to 400 degrees F.

- 2. Drain and rinse chickpeas then transfer to a bowl. Use a paper towel and pat chickpeas as dry as possible. If some of the skins fall off, remove them from the bowl.
- 3. Add the coconut oil, salt and pepper to bowl and toss to combine. Transfer the chickpeas to a baking sheet.
- 4. Roast the chickpeas for 45 minutes stirring every 10 minutes. If adding flavors, remove after 30 minutes, add spices and return to oven for remaining 15 minutes.
