

FLAVORS OF DECEPTION

*“Encourage one another day after day, as long as it is called ‘Today’, so that none of you will be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin”
(Hebrews 3:13)*

- 1 **Luke 3:12-14** Maintaining truth as a soldier. John encourages honesty and contentment
- 2 **Ja 4:7** Resist the devil. Submit to God
- 3 **1 P 5:8** Devil seeking someone to devour. Be sober and alert that you not be devoured
- 4 **1 John 3:8** Sin is being in accordance with the devil (*1 Jn 4:1*)
- 5 **Jude 1:9** We should bring no scoffing nor accusation against the devil
- 6 **Rev 12:9** The devil and his angels deceive the whole world
- 7 **Eph 6:11** God’s word is our protection. Preparation for deployment
- 8 **1 Tim 3:6** Pride like that of the devil in the Christian (*Eze 28:14-18*)
- 9 **1 Tim 3:7** The devil has many strategies to snare us
- 10 **1 Tim 6:20-21** Avoid worldly knowledge (i.e philosophy, psychology)
- 11 **2 Tim 2:26** Christians taken captive by the devil to do his will
- 12 **2 Tim 3:1-7** Christians caught in deception and iniquity
- 13 **Matt 26:20** False witnesses against the perfect Christ
- 14 **2 P 2:1** Christian false teachers
- 15 **Rev 2:2** False apostles (*2 Cor 11:13*)
- 16 **Gal 2:4** False brethren, danger because of (*2 Cor 11:26*)
- 17 **Matt 15:19** Out of the heart comes blasphemies
- 18 **Matt 7:15** False prophets can be detected by what is under the surface. Examine the doctrine closely
- 19 **Mark 13:22** False prophets manifest signs and wonders
- 20 **Luke 6:26** Men speaking well of a person is not necessarily a sign of credibility

- 21 **1 P 2:12** Behavior excellent above reproach is the prerequisite to pleasing God
(1 P 4:15)
- 22 **1 P 2:13-14** Respect for Government (Rulers)
- 23 **1 Sam 15:23** For stubbornness God will reject us. Adopt a willingness to do God's will
- 24 **Job 4:8** This statement is true, but not in the case of Job (he was passing through undeserved suffering)
- 25 **Psa 6:8** Prayer for protection from evil
- 26 **Psa 36:2-3** The wicked take delight in deceit
Ro 1:32
- 27 **Psa 36:11-12** The wicked are cast down
- 28 **Psa 59:2** Prayer for deliverance from evil
- 29 **Psa 66:18** Turn away from sin, look to God
- 30 **Rev 2:10** Satan has power to influence authorities
- 31 **Matt 13:22** Deceitfulness of riches
- 32 **1 Tim 3:11** Women be not gossips, but faithful in everything
- 33 **Titus 2:3** Older women not false accusers
- 34 **Rev 21:7-8** Those identified with sin vs. those empowered to overcome
- 35 **Psa 119:133** Let not iniquity have dominion over me. Power from God to do his will
- 36 **Prov 12:20-22** The just person is protected from evil. God delights in truth
- 37 **Prov 21:15** Destruction to the workers of iniquity
- 38 **Isa 1:17** Seek justice for the weak
- 39 **Isa 55:7** Let the wicked forsake his way. God pardons us when we return to Him
1 John 1:9
- 40 **Eze 11:2** Wicked counsel
- 41 **Zec 10:2** Idols and spiritists (i.e. witches) have spoken in vain

- 42 **Job 36:10-12** God opens our ears to return from iniquity. If we hear Him we will have prosperity and pleasure in latter days
- 43 **Job 36:21** Turning to evil means affliction
- 44 **Psa 5:5** The boastful shall not stand before God
- 45 **Psa 41:6** Iniquity can not be concealed
1 Tim 5:24-25
- 46 **Job 34:12** God will not pervert judgment
- 47 **1 Chro 10:13** Dying for seeking a spiritist. We do not seek counsel from a witch
- 48 **Ezrah 9:2** Israel mingling with the surrounding nations (Us preferring the company of unbelievers)
- 49 **Eze 18:24** A man's righteousness will not save if he sins
- 50 **Matt 4:1-2** Jesus was tempted 40 days by the devil. There was severe suffering from hunger
- 51 **Luke 8:12** The injustice of the devil. God provides more opportunities
- 52 **John 13:2** The devil can put things in our hearts. He can plant seeds there
- 53 **Acts 10:38** The devil (i.e. demons) oppresses people
- 54 **Acts 13:10** Some choose to be children of the devil
- 55 **Jer 48:10 (b)** Sometimes not going to war is sin (*Num 32:20-23*)
- 56 **Psa 101:7** Liars have no fellowship with God
- 57 **Prov 10:4** Poverty to the negligent hand
- 58 **Psa 52:2-4** A man's tongue can be like a razor. Hurting other people in vain
- 59 **Hosea 11:12** Nations that become liars
- 60 **Mi 6:10-13** God can not pardon false measuring. False scales. (*c.f. Luke 6:38*)
Prov 20:23
- 61 **Jer 9:6** Sin was keeping God's people from knowing Him
- 62 **Jer 9:8** Speaking peaceably but inward hatred
- 63 **Psa 24:3-6** The man of pure heart may stand (i.e fellowship with) before the Lord
- 64 **Psa 34:11-16** Keep our tongue from Guile!!

- 65 **Psa 50:20-22** Do not slander a blood brother
- 66 **Psa 55:23** Deceitful men shall not live half their days. Life cut short because of sin
- 67 **Prov 14:25** A true witness delivers souls
- 68 **Zeph 3:13** The remnant is free of Deceitfulness and none shall make them afraid. Security because of God's power
- 69 **Eze 13:7** Saying the Lord has spoken and He had not
- 70 **Eze 13:19, 22** By lies the innocent die and the guilty live
- 71 **Prov 6:16-19** The man that sows discord among brothers
- 72 **Prov 19:5** A false witness shall not go unpunished
- 73 **Prov 21:28** A false witness shall perish
- 74 **Prov 23:3** Do not desire the delicacies of the rich
- 75 **Gen 3:6** Lust for the forbidden fruit or something God would forbid us to partake of
- 76 **Ex 20:17** Lust for another man's wife
- 77 **Ex 34:24** God's protection of property to the faithful
- 78 **Deu 5:21** Covet not neighbor's house, field servants or livestock
- 79 **Deu 7:25** Desire not the gold or silver of the images, or it will be a snare to us
- 80 **Jos 7:21** Greed took over his heart
- 81 **Psa 19:9-11** The word of God is more desirable than gold or honey (i.e. things, food)
- 82 **Prov 6:23-25** Do not desire the beauty of the adulteress nor get caught by her eyes
- 83 **Prov 21:20** There is desire that is not lust (*good things from the Lord*)
1 Thes 4:11-12
- 84 **Isa 1:29-30** Distraction from God by nature itself. Environment provides no salvation
Jer 3:23
- 85 **Isa 44:9** None shall profit from an image –nothing from our art or

craftsmanship

- 86 **Micah 2:1-2** War for the purpose of Greedy Gain
Ja 4:1-4
- 87 **Ex 15:9** War for the purpose of Lustful Gain. The pursuit of things through conquest that is contrary to God's justice and will
- 88 **Matt 5:28** Looking on a woman with lust is equivalent to Adultery
- 89 **Rom 1:27** Homosexuality always condemned
- 90 **Ga 5:16** Walk in the Spirit versus Lust -God's will for your life
- 91 **Ja 1:14-15** Every man has an area of weakness that will be tempted to lust if we are not sowing to the spirit. Failure to check sin results in premature death
- 92 **2 P 1:4** We escape from lust by concentration on the word of God. The word of God is our relationship with Him
- 93 **1 John 2:16** Lust is of the world
- 94 **1 John 2:17** The lust of the world and the flesh are going to pass away
- 95 **Mark 4:19** Lust for money and things chokes the word of God and makes us unfruitful. Very important thing for all of us to think about
- 96 **John 8:44** The Devil is a murderer and a liar and a father of lies
- 97 **Rom 6:12** Do not obey the Lust, look to God
- 98 **Rom 13:14** Do not make provision for the flesh. Avoid temptation, turn away from it
- 99 **1 Tim 6:9** Lust for money causes sin. A prime symptom of this problem is failure to assemble with the brethren
- 100 **2 Tim 2:22** Flee youthful lusts
- 101 **2 Tim 4:3-4** Not wanting God's word but rather entertainment. Enticed or seduced by the world
- 102 **Titus 2:11-12** Deny worldly lust
- 103 **Titus 3:3** Christians get caught in these behaviors. Have mercy for them
- 104 **1 P 4:1-2** If we are suffering in the flesh it is so that we will live for God and not

in Lust

- 105 **Num 11:4** Lusting for food (*meat*)
- 106 **Col 3:5-6, 25** Not setting aside these deeds of darkness makes us sons of disobedience and enemies of God
- 107 **Eph 2:3** All of us were children of wrath until we wanted Christ
- 108 **Jer 15:18** False accusation against God
- 109 **Num 23:19** God keeps His word
- 110 **Psa 78:36-37** Many refuse to remain faithful. Even if we are faithless He remains faithful (*see 2 Tim 2:13*)
- 111 **Psa 89:35-36** God does not break promises
- 112 **Psa 116:11** Men get caught in lies
- 113 **Isa 57:11** Spiritual decline of such that the person is not afraid to lie
- 114 **Mt 5:33-37** Do not swear. Let your yes be yes, and your no be no
- 115 **Deu 19:18-19** Do not deal falsely against a brother
- 116 **1 K 22:23** The Lord's sovereign will is done
Prov 16:4
- 117 **Psa 52:1-5** Men who love falsehood
- 118 **Psa 63:11** Liars will be stopped
- 119 **Psa 119:29** The desire to be free from Lying. God is our escape from the lie
- 120 **Psa 119:69** Maintaining a course with God despite the opposition and potential distraction. God can help us with this, if we do not refuse –resent-His discipline
- 121 **Psa 119:128** Hating the false way
- 122 **Prov 6:16-17** God hates a lying tongue
- 123 **Prov 12:19** Lips of truth shall be established
- 124 **Prov 12:22** “Lying lips are an abomination to the Lord”
- 125 **Prov 21:6** The acquisition of wealth through lying

- 126 **Prov 31:30** Charm is deceitful
- 127 **Isa 28:15** For we have made falsehood our refuge
- 128 **Isa 57:4** Children of rebellion
- 129 **Isa 59:1-3** Fall of iniquity
- 130 **Zec 8:17** Let none imagine evil against his neighbor
- 131 **Jer 5:2** This can only be said in the spirit of truth (*“They speak to me with their mouth... their heart far from me”*)
- 132 **Jer 6:13-14** A nation caught in greed. There is no peace
- 133 **Jer 7:8-10** We won’t be delivered if we don’t forsake sin
- 134 **Jer 8:8** Changing or softening the words
- 135 **Jer 10:14-15** Images are a work of mockery, and also seeking peace with the devil
- 136 **Eze 13:22** Lies make the righteous sad and strengthen the wicked
- 137 **Habb 2:18** An image is a teacher of falsehood. Very important
- 138 **Eph 4:14-15** Don’t be put off balance by false doctrine. Speak the truth in love
- 139 **Matt 5:11** We are blessed when we pass testing
- 140 **Acts 5:3** Satan filling the heart leads to lying to the Spirit
- 141 **Rom 9:1** Speaking the truth in the Holy Spirit
- 142 **Col 3:9** Lie not to each other. Lay aside the old self
- 143 **Ja 3:14** Do not lie against the truth
- 144 **1 John 1:6** If we say we have fellowship with God and are sinning we are liars
- 145 **Rom 1:25** Those who give up the truth for the lies now, used to seek the truth in the past
- 146 **Eph 4:25** Put away lying: Speak the truth with neighbors. Members of one another
- 147 **1 John 2:21** No lie is of the truth

- 148 **Prov 14:5** A faithful witness will not lie
- 149 **Prov 30:6** To add words is to be found a liar
- 150 **Lev 6:2-3** If we lie and it results in a loss to another, we repay the person plus 20%
- 151 **Hsa 11:12** A nation not faithful will not rule with God
- 152 **Job 34:12** God does not regard falsehood
- 153 **Psa 127:1** Unless the Lord helps us, we labor in vain (*No increase*)
- 154 **Psa 144:8-11** Speak vanity, right hand of falsehood
- 155 **Prov 30:7-9** Desire to be honest of heart
- 156 **Ex 23:6-9** Have a judicious heart
- 157 **Psa 31:18** Lies will be silenced
- 158 **Psa 33:13-22** Trust in the Lord
- 159 **Psa 120:1-4** Believers who lie will suffer divine discipline (i.e arrows and burning)
- 160 **Prov 11:18** A sure reward
- 161 **Prov 26:20-6** What's inside the whisperer's heart? Deceit
- 162 **Jer 8:5-6** Refusing to return (to say "What have I done?")
- 163 **Rom 1:28-29** Refusing God results in multiplication of lusts and wickedness
- 164 **Col 2:8** Don't get caught in philosophy
- 165 **Jer 17:9** Deceitful is our heart. We need to be washed daily with the word of God
- 166 **Eph 4:22-25** Lay aside the old self; speak the truth
- 167 **2 Cor 4:2** Appealing to every man's conscience
- 168 **Heb 3:13** Exhort each other daily or we will be hardened by sin
- 169 **2 Thes 2:10** Wickedness instead of truth for unbelievers who hate the truth

- 170 **Matt 24:5** False Christs saying, I am the One
- 171 **Matt 24:11** Many false prophets
- 172 **Rom 16:18** Men (believers) led by their emotions have smooth and flattering speech that deceive many
- 173 **1 Cor 3:18** Become a fool to become wise. A special discipline for the arrogant
- 174 **Eph 4:14** Stand firm; Resist false doctrine
- 175 **Eph 5:6** Don't be deceived by empty words
- 176 **2 Thes 2:2-3** After the rapture, total apostasy and the antichrist come
- 177 **1 Jn 1:8** If we say we have no sin we are deceived
- 178 **Rev 20:2** Satan bound for one thousand years (demons also)
- 179 **Rev 20:3, 8** Satan let out once more
- 180 **Gen 30:25-43** We get God's help if we endure injustice with a clean heart
Gen 31:1-7
- 181 **Deu 11:16** Don't turn to other gods
- 182 **Isa 44:17** Prayer to an image is futile (*Is 44:9-20*)
- 183 **Jer 20:7-8** Accusing God of deception. Believers do this
- 184 **1 Cor 15:33** Bad companies corrupt good morals
- 185 **Gal 6:7** What we saw we reap
- 186 **1 Tim 2:14** The woman deceived. The man understood the consequences
- 187 **2 Tim 3:13** Many impostors
- 188 **Matt 27:63** Jesus accused of being a deceiver (*John 7:12*)
- 189 **2 John 1:7** Many deceivers –antichrists
- 190 **2 Cor 6:8** Christians considered as deceivers
- 191 **Gal 6:3** Arrogance
- 192 **Ja 1:22** Hearers of the word and not doers deceive themselves and others
- 193 **Ja 1:26** Not able to hold the tongue deceives

- 194 **2 P 2:13** Completely absorbed in deception, and deceiving other believers also
- 195 **Deu 13:1-5** Dreamer put to death
- 196 **Lev 19:31** Be not defiled by the wizards (i.e. witches)
- 197 **Deu 18:9-12** Witches are detestable. They are not to be among us
- 198 **1 Tim 3:3, 8** Greedy for gain
- 199 **Lev 20:6-8** The Lord will cut off the person amongst us who turns to Mediums
