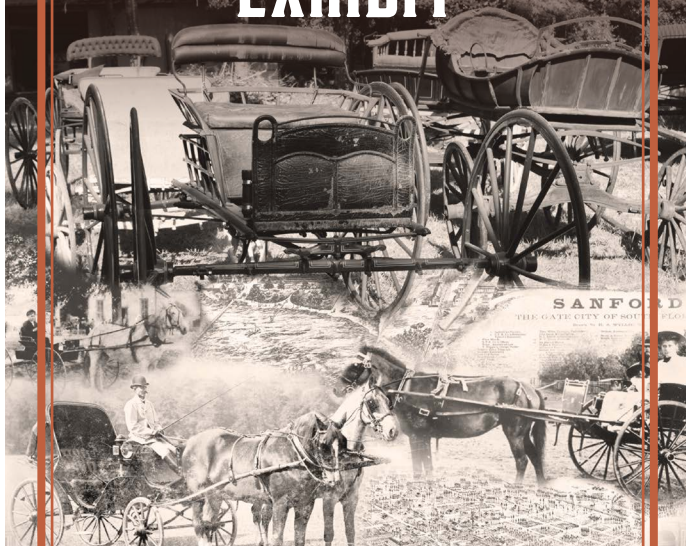


HELP US BUILD THE BILL NYGREN BUGGY EXHIBIT
