The Seminole County Historical Society is a 501-C-3 non-profit membership organization that raises funds, conducts programs, and supports the efforts of the Museum of Seminole County History. The museum preserves and educates the public about the history of the towns and residents of Seminole County and its rich past. Organized in 1994, the Society has contributed services, funding and expertise for such projects as the building of the Agricultural Exhibits building, the Pole Barn, museum labeling and exhibitions and the publishing of a number of high-quality historical books.

The Society is governed by a Board of Directors. The directors serve annual terms that are renewable. All positions are of a volunteer nature. There is no paid compensation for serving in this position.

To apply for a position on the board, the applicant must be a member of the Seminole County Historical Society. Residency in Seminole County is not a requirement. Applicants who are invited to join the board must be able to attend board meetings which are held on the third Thursday of each month from 1-3pm at the museum.
