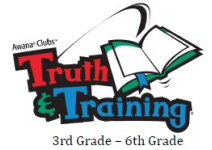

Your child's first book and uniform are included in the \$30 registration fee. If they are lost, replacements will cost additional money.

Going Home Time! Cubbies will remain in their room for pick up. Sparks and TnT clubbers will be in the Fellowship Hall and you will need to come into the Fellowship Hall for them to be released, kids will not be able to leave the building alone. Kids are not allowed to run around the building.
