- » Program time is 6:30-8 p.m., registration starts at 6:15 p.m. **Please be prompt with picking up your child.**
- » **Going Home Time!** Cubbies will remain in their room for pick up. Sparks and TnT clubbers will be in the Fellowship Hall and you will need to come into the Fellowship Hall for them to be released, kids will not be able to leave the building alone. Kids are not allowed to run around the building.
- » Search "Awana" in iTunes or GooglePlay for audio downloads and games!
 - » Make sure picture of album matches their book and you choose the **ESV version!**
- » Once or twice a month there will be a theme night. They are designated on the calendar.
 - » These are not mandatory, but a fun way for the kids to be excited about coming to club.
 - » *They will also earn extra points for participation in these nights.
- » Your child's first book and uniform are included in the \$30 registration fee. If they are lost, replacements will cost additional money.
- » **Please be sure you download the 'Remind' app and enter class code: 469878.**
 - » This is how I will update you regarding cancellations, important announcements, and reminders.
- » Once again we will be participating in a missions activity to help the kids gain excitement with helping reach others. We have adopted Haiti We encourage each clubber to bring a donation each week, even if it's just a quarter.
