Adat Reyim is offering three camps this summer – Preschool Camp, June Summer Camp and July Summer Camp. Each camp has different themes that offer campers a chance to expand their horizons, make new friends and have lots of fun!

ADAT REYIM PRESCHOOL CAMP

This four-day camp runs during the last week of public school when Fairfax County Public Schools are still in session. (*Monday, June 6 is a Jewish holiday, and the synagogue will be closed.*)

Dates: Tuesday, June 7 – Friday, June 10 from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM

Theme for the Week -- **MONSTER MASH** – Campers will discover that Monsters are cute, friendly, and love to have fun! Campers will read books about Monster buddies and make friendly Monsters that can come home and live with them.

There will be challah (bread) baking on Friday.

ADAT REYIM JUNE SUMMER CAMP

This three-week camp runs from Monday, June 13 through Friday, July 1 from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM.

Themes:

Week 1 – BUDDING BUILDERS – Campers will make their creations with a variety of materials and tools. Building, constructing, imagining – all in a hands-on, interactive, team environment. There will be building challenges and art projects, too.

Week 2 – ZOO-MAZING – Zoo animals are many things. Some are furry, some have feathers, and some have nothing at all (naked mole rat!) Campers will learn what zoo

animals sound like, feel like and what they do all day. This and more at the pretend visit to the zoo.

Week 3 – A CAMPING WE WILL GO – Campers will explore the fun of the great outdoors. Campers will also craft all the supplies needed for an exciting, pretend camp out. "Campfires," canteens, and s'mores.

ADAT REYIM JULY SUMMER CAMP

This four-week camp runs from Tuesday, July 5 through Friday, July 29 from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM. (Monday, July 4 is a holiday.)

Themes:

Week 1 – KINGS, QUEENS, DRAGONS AND CASTLES – Campers can be a king or a queen of a kingdom. They will make a dragon and a horse to ride, and construct a castle, too. Plenty of opportunities for pretend play in a medieval setting

Week 2 – JURASSIC GIANTS – Dinosaurs will come to life during this prehistoric-themed week. Campers will imagine what it would be like if dinosaurs were still roaming around the earth. Campers will make dino feet, have dino stomp dance parties and construct a huge exploding volcano! Campers will explore the Jurassic World and the unbelievable creatures that roamed the earth millions of years ago.

Week 3 – OCEAN COMMOTION – Campers will dive right into the ocean by learning about all kinds of ocean animals. They will discover what exactly it is that they do all day swimming in the deep blue sea. Treasure hunt included.

Week 4 – CARNIVAL FIESTA –Summer carnival time! Together, campers will create masks, tame carnival "animals," and play lots of carnival games. Popcorn will be popped, and pretend cotton candy will be created. Come one and come all!

MORE CAMP INFORMATION

- Camp is open to 2 ½ year olds through rising first graders.
- Campers are grouped by age.
- Campers can participate in all three sessions of camp if desired. NOTE: The four-day Preschool Camp is only open to 2½ year olds through rising Kindergarteners since it overlaps with the last week of FCPS.
- All campers must be potty trained. However, the 2 ½ year old campers do not need to be potty trained but should have experience separating from their caregivers.
- Priority registration will be given to current preschool families, synagogue members and returning summer camp families.
- All campers must have a completed health form and must be current on immunizations before starting camp.
- Camp fees include all activities, supplies, enrichment, and a daily morning snack.
- Campers must bring a lunch every day. Because we are a Kosher facility, please do not include poultry (turkey, chicken), beef, pork, shellfish, or nuts in your child's lunch. Items such as eggs, fish (salmon, tuna), yogurt cheese, crackers, bread, fruits, and veggies are all acceptable to bring to camp. For example, cheese or veggie pizza is allowed, but pepperoni is not. Sunflower butter is acceptable, but peanut butter or any nut butter is not allowed.
- Camp fees are nonrefundable.
