- Place the overall health and temperament of this breed first and foremost, knowing the future of the breed depends upon it.

- Maintains all health and registration records properly and according to UKC Rules and Regulations.

- Represent our breed with respectability and sportsmanship in and out of the show ring.

- Refrain from public degradation or criticism of others or their dogs being ever mindful it can influence the public's reaction to the sport of purebred dogs.

- Are always fair and honest in all of their dealings with all puppy buyers.

- Encourage puppy buyers to register their puppies with UKC and participate in one or more of UKC's events.
- Encourage, educate and welcome new visitors and members to the sport of purebred dogs, the UTRTCA and the UKC.
