

Formal Concert Attire

Students are expected to wear the following at every non-themed concert and for KMEA Performances.

- BLACK WESTPORT BAND POLO ...tucked in
- BLACK Pants
- BLACK Belt
- BLACK Socks
- BLACK Dress/Casual Dress Shoes
- Remember, **the point of a uniform is so that the whole group looks the same.** We don't want anyone to stick out and draw the audience's attention away from the music. Concerts are formal occasions and the performers should be dressed up!



Here is a picture of the band polo.

The design will not change, so you only need to buy it once. It would be wise to buy the shirt a little larger than what your student currently wears so that they can “grow” into it.

This polo will always be the concert attire we use. Find the link to order it under the “Swag” tab.

Students are permitted to wear skirts with the polo, if they prefer. The requirement for a skirt is that it has to be solid black and must cover past the knee. Considering that we sit for the majority of our performances, it's important that students are focused on playing and not if their attire covers them properly.

Other attire for optional events

Pep Band

For pep band performances, students will simply be required to wear a blue Westport t-shirt. A blue Westport Pep Band t-shirt will be available through the “Swag” tab on the website, if students would like to purchase one.

Solo and Ensemble

Students are expected to “Dress to impress” for a solo and ensemble performance. Clothes that you would wear to special events, church, or other formal occasions are highly encouraged.
