BEGINNING JUNE 1, 2025, SUNSHINE DISPOSAL WILL BE INCREASING THEIR RATES 2.9%.

The City of Sprague Ordinances are codified and enforceable. Starting the beginning of this month, ordinances will be enforced. The website to view ordinances is https://sprague.municipal.codes.

In case of a water emergency after hours please contact Public Works at 509-570-3219. It is \$100 fine for tampering with water meters (to turn water meters off and on yourself).

In case of emergencies, city hall needs updated phone numbers from residents.

The City of Sprague is thrilled to introduce TextMyGov, a convenient and smart text messaging service! This service will enable residents to effortlessly receive important notifications and easily find specific information by texting the city. Text the city at 509-257-4616. Residents may receive a text message from 91896 from the City of Sprague initiating the service. You can choose to opt-out at any time by texting STOP.

City Hall and animal control needs proof of rabies. Dogs that are spayed/neutered are \$45, if not, \$55. We have had several complaints regarding dogs making messes in people's yards. Please have respect for others; keep your dog's off of private property and clean up after them!

Time to clean up city right aways. If there are vehicles not with current registrations on city right aways; they will be towed at owners expense.

Remember visiting RVs requires a permit in city limits. You can get one at city hall or online for free.

Please take your garbage cans out Thursday night or by 6 am for pick-up or they will not be picked up. After pickup, please remove cans off the street and sidewalks. Yard waste is not allowed in garbage cans.

If you are planning on building, remodeling, etc. on your property, you need to check with the city and county for zoning requirements and building permits prior to construction.

To save our sewer system and cost to the community, please remember not to flush baby, adult & Clorox wipes, Swiffer's, feminine products, paper towels, etc.

Burn barrels are illegal in the State of Washington, DO NOT use them. Burn permits are required for burning within city limits. They are \$10 per day.
