Starting in April we will start reading meters!

Interested in becoming an EMT, Ambulance driver, or Fire fighter? The Sprague Fire Dept is looking for help, must be 18 or older. Contact the Fire Department at 509-257-2926.

In case of emergencies, city hall needs updated phone numbers and mailing addresses. City Hall needs proof of rabies before dogs can be licensed. Dogs that are spayed or neutered are \$20, if not, \$30. If dogs are not licensed by March 1st, dog owners will be subject to a \$25 late fee. Remember visiting RVs requires a permit to be in city limits. You can get one at city hall. Please put your garbage cans out by 7 am for easy pick-up or they won't be picked up. After pick-up, please remove cans off the street and sidewalks. Yard waste is not allowed in garbage cans.

If you are planning on building, remodeling, etc. on your property, you need to check with the city and county for zoning requirements and building permits prior to construction.

To save our sewer system and cost to the community, please remember not to flush baby, adult & Clorox wipes, Swiffer's, feminine products, etc.

City Hall has been receiving calls about burning trash. Burn barrels are illegal in the State of Washington, so **DO NOT** use them. Burn permits are required for burning within city limits. They are \$10 per day.
