To save our sewer system and cost to the community, please remember not to flush baby, adult or Clorox wipes, Swiffer's, feminine products, etc.

Garbage cans need to be out Thursday night or 6 am Friday or they won't be picked up. Make sure garbage cans are not next to anything. If garbage didn't get picked up call SUNSHINE DISPOSAL at 509-924-5678 option 2.

City is still under a burn ban.

City Hall has been receiving calls about burning trash. Burn barrels are illegal in the State of Washington, so DO NOT use them. Burn permits are required for burning within city limits. They are \$10 per day.

If you have chickens, you need to remember they are to be kept in a chicken coop and not running loose.

If you have not licensed your dog, it needs to be done! Fees are double and if your dog is caught outside your property without a license, you will be subject to a \$150 fine. We also require proof of rabies vaccination. Please remember to clean up after your dog's when walking them.

Remember visiting RVs requires a permit to stay in city limits. They are available at city hall.

If you are planning on building or remodeling your property, you need to check with the city for zoning requirements and the county for building permits prior to construction.
