Open Meeting:

Mayor Pro Tem Coombs called the council meeting to order at 7:00 P.M., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Council members answered to roll call: Trace DeGarmo, Randy Westfall, Shawn Coombs, and Michelle Barrus. Westfall moved to excuse Mayor Stephens and Aaron Snider they were absent due to illness. Barrus seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.

Approve/amend Agenda:

DeGarmo moved to approve agenda as amended. Barrus seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.

Land Use Application Public Hearing: Public Hearing for Randy Westfall's Land Use Application opened at 7:02 p.m. There were no objections. Shirley St. James said good luck! Public Hearing Closed at 7:03 p.m.

Council Meeting went back into session at 7:03 p.m.

Century West – Dan Remmick: We should be ready to advertise to go to bid for the Lift Station in the next couple of weeks. We are probably in a better position now to start the project since there was so much groundwater earlier this season.

Dan has been working closely with FEMA to get the application in for Walnut and Colfax. Dan is getting estimates together. They are also looking at H Street Bridge and the wall by the park that sustained damage during the flood. Dan would like to put together a task order that will be in the range of around \$1,000 for the work and will bring it to the next meeting.

TIB applications are due August 20th. We need to update the Six Year Transportation Plan to submit to QUADCO so we can apply for grants. The projects have to be listed on the plan to be eligible for TIB funding. We will hold a public hearing for the STIP on July 19th. Rob Simon asked if they would be doing any work to Dayton Street to raise it up when they do the lift station. Dan explained that was not funded in the CDBG grant but something we can look into it for a street project.

Public Comment:

Rob Simon- Mr. Simon inquired about the trailer at the Viking. He asked why a public hearing wasn't held, and that it goes against the City Zoning Ordinance, and when is the City going to start enforcing the ordinances. Coombs said that the building was supposed to be placed in a different location at the Viking but due to flooding it was placed in the spot it currently is. Simon was concerned that it is a mobile trailer and can't be there.

Council said they would have to review the zoning ordinance to find out if a violation exists. More discussion followed.

Virgil Askren asked about when lines would be painted on the street over by the gas station. We will have to check with Canaday. People tend to think the whole area is a parking lot and it is a safety hazard.

Minutes:

The minutes from the June 21, 2017 Council meeting were presented to council. Westfall moved to approve the minutes from the June 21, 2017 Council meeting. DeGarmo seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.

New Business:

Motorcycle Parking on First Street: Westfall would like to find out what we need to do to have some motorcycle parking on First Street. Westfall was thinking about 20 feet or so of motorcycle parking. We will have to do some research and will work on it.

Lagoon 799 Ordinance: Council would like to look into charging again per the Ordinance already in place, but would like to wait until a full council is present to discuss.
