The annual property tax collection falls short of covering the basic maintenance expenses. The sale of lots and donations are necessary to maintain at the present level. The special levy that is put before our patrons every four years in the amount of approximately \$35,000 is crucial. The extra revenue is used for well maintenance and lawn mower/equipment repair/replacement. At the present time, we are looking at updating our outdated electrical panel with phase 3 wiring with pump controls, switches, and materials to code. This would not have been possible without the approved special levy three years ago. We appreciate your continued support and we will continue to be frugal with your money.
