### Regarding RV occupancy...

There is a city ordinance stating, no person shall occupy any trailer, or recreational vehicle on any premises which is situated outside an approved mobile home park, except with certain circumstances.

If you have someone living in a trailer or RV, please come to City Hall. The City Clerk/Treasurer may issue special written permits allowing guests visiting a resident of the city to sleep in a trailer or recreational vehicle for a period of seven days with written permission of the property owner with whom they are staying.

If you have received a letter, you have 30-days from the date of letter to remedy the situation. - Thank you
