Meeting was called to order at 10:05 by Chairman Vic Scalone. Pledge was recited. Minutes of the May 8 Monthly Board Meeting and the May 20 Special Board Meeting were read by Eileen Cantwell. Hank made a motion to accept the Minutes as read, seconded by Hannah. Passed.
