- I understand that SBPOA assumes no liability for my watercraft. Storage on the SBPOA racks is at my own risk. SBPOA reserves the right to remove my watercraft if it is found in other than my assigned spot(s).
- I agree to remove my watercraft from the racks no later than **October 1, 2023**. *I understand that any watercraft left past that date is subject to confiscation and resale, and my rack spot(s) will be reassigned to another member in the following year.*
