Eugene wants to continue to build the business here in Sound Beach and hopefully be-


come a fixture in the community. He plans to eventually renovate and make the Sound Beach Diner an even more comfortable option for Sound Beach residents.



The Sound Beach Property Owners' Association Clubhouse sits comfortably atop the highest point in Sound Beach.

This charming building is home to many of SBPOA's exciting events and meetings, and is available to rent for private events.

The Clubhouse is perfect for showers, birthday, engagement, Christening, graduation or holiday parties.

The rental cost for SBPOA members in good standing is \$300 with an additional \$200 refundable security deposit. Non-SBPOA members may rent the clubhouse for \$500 and an additional \$200 refundable security deposit.
