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

Memories were shared all night, friendships renewed and there was plenty of music by EJ and the B Side Band.





SOUND BEACH MEMORIES

My Sound Beach

I have lived in Sound Beach since before I was born. My parents bought the house in 1940, and we'd spend summers here. My parents continued coming out every summer well into the 1970's. I have two early memories of my childhood summers. My favorite is walking to the beach very early in the morning with my Collie dog, Beau. No one else was up. There were hummingbirds, warm sunshine and I was safe. It was mostly woods, with a few bungalows along the way. And no traffic. None. When I was about 10 years old, my mother would let me walk up to Calace's (as we called the Superior Market back then) in the Square to buy bologna for weekend lunch sandwiches. There was sawdust on the floor near the 'deli' department in the back. I was very proud of my accomplishment of keeping the food safe (from Beau, mostly) on my way back home. The beach – oh my beach. We actually had a beach back then. It was big and broad and it didn't matter if it was high tide. We always had a beach. And we 'hung' out in groups of friends, listening to the portable radios for the most recent hits. Or we'd swim to the end of the ropes, to Dog's, or Whales, or for the most adventurous, to Pinpoint. We'd spend all day at the beach and were exhausted by the time we came home at night. Our mothers never had to worry, because everyone in Sound Beach looked out for each other. We were a real community. We also spent a lot of time up at the candy store in the Square. As younger teens we'd spend Friday nights at the Community House (now Bedrossian Real Estate) listening to Rock and Roll, playing ping pong and knock hockey and dancing. As older teens, we'd spend Saturday night at the Club House dancing and talking and laughing. And we'd walk home in the dark safely. There are still threads of that Eden woven through the fabric of today's Sound Beach in the people who help each other, who step up when friends and neighbors are in need. I was a very, very lucky kid to have spent my summers in Sound Beach. And even though so much has changed, I am still a very lucky retiree to be able to live in Sound Beach today. But some things never change: My favorite place in the world.

The Clubhouse is available for rentals!

The Sound Beach Property Owners' Association Clubhouse sits comfortably atop the highest point in Sound Beach.

This charming building is home to many of SBPOA's exciting events and meetings, and is available to rent for private events. The Clubhouse is perfect for showers, birthday, engagement, Christening, graduation or holiday parties.
