- Has 20 detox beds, average length of stay is 3-7 days. Has fentanyl detox protocol, and treatment for alcohol, heroin, cocaine, pain medications, and benzodiazepines.

- 6-month inpatient program for pregnant women and parenting women with children under 6 years old. They can work with women's who have children in CPS custody.
- Mother's room and board, treatment, and childcare is covered by Medicaid. Child's room and board is \$194/ month; TANF may cover this expense, they will work with clients to complete TANF application
- No detox services but can work with detox providers for a direct transfer; requires a CD assessment recommending inpatient services
- Only accepts Medicaid
