கடவுள், மனித இனம் தவிர வேறு எந்த ஜீவராசியும், இந்த தலைப்பிற்கு கவனம் செலுத்துவதில்லை. எல்லைச்சாமி, தெய்வம் , குலதெய்வம், ஆண்டவன் , கடவுள் , இறைவன் என்று நிலம் மற்றும் பழக்கவழக்கத்திற்கு ஏற்றார் போல் நம்மை ஆளுகிற சக்திகளை வெவ்வேறு பெயர் கொண்டு வணங்குவது இயல்பு . நம் குலம் வந்தவர்கள் குலதெய்வம் , இரு உலகத்தையும் ஆள்பவன் ஆண்டவன், அனைத்தையும் கடந்து, அளவிடமுடியாமல், நம்முள்ளும் வாழ்பவன் கடவுள். இறைவனுக்கு நிகர் இறைவன், அதற்கு மேல் வேறுஒன்றுமில்லை. ஒரு ஜனநாயக நாட்டின் இறையாண்மை(sovereign), மக்கள் வாக்கு, சவுரன் (Gold Standard) என்ற சொல் இதை தழுவி வந்ததே என்கிறார்கள். சமகாலத்தில் , கடந்த அரை நூற்றாண்டுக நம்மில் பல பேருக்கு பரிட்சயப்பட்ட ஒரு கண்கண்ட கடவுளை பற்றிய ஒரு சிறு Bird's eye View இது. அது வேற யாரும் இல்லங்க "கார்பொரேட்" எனும் மிக பெரிய சக்தி.

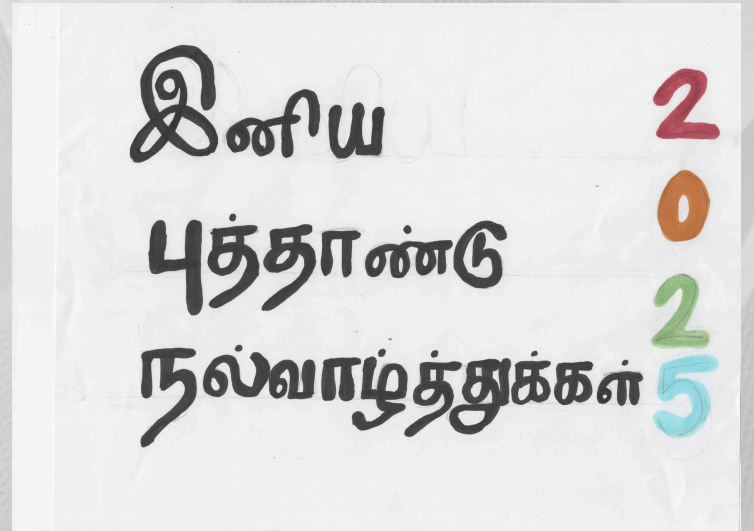

Tell us about your journey to USA

I graduated from Madras Medical College in 2001. In the same year, I made my first out-of-the-country move to Birmingham, Alabama, where I joined a Master's degree in Public Health (MPH) at the University of Alabama at Birmingham (UAB). After completing my MPH degree, I moved to Lubbock, Texas, to begin my pediatric residency. From there, life brought me back to Alabama, where I worked as a general pediatrician for five years in a small town called Alexander City. Later I moved back to UAB to get educational training on taking care of very preterm babies. Following that, I spent nearly a decade teaching at UAB as a neonatologist. During this time, I took on the role of Fellowship Program Directorship for neonatology, where I balanced patient care, research, and education. I eventually became a leader in the global health research program focusing on developing low-cost tools to prevent brain injury among children born in low-resource birthing facilities. Currently, I conduct global health research across six countries in three continents: Zambia, Kenya, Guatemala, India, Pakistan, and the Democratic Republic of Congo, involving a team of 100 members, including doctors, nurses, midwives and social workers. With a drive to do more and different things, pursued a Master's in Healthcare Administration at UAB, a degree similar to an MBA but tailored to run hospitals. I did not stop there. I went on to complete another master's in Hospital Safety and Quality.

Within nine years as a faculty member at UAB, I became a pediatrics professor in 2022. At the same time, I received an offer and joined the University of South Alabama, Mobile, as the Division Chief of Neonatology. In May 2024, I was appointed Chief Medical Officer for the Women and Children's Hospital, overseeing special care, clinical operations, quality, and budgeting while managing a large team and hospital operations.

Alongside these responsibilities, I continue to lead global research initiatives. On the personal side, family is my top priority. I owe a great deal to my wife, Kartika, whose unwavering support has been vital to my career. She takes care of my physical and mental well-being, allowing me to thrive. We have two wonderful daughters who are also a huge part of my life.

How do you stay rooted in your Tamil culture?

Early on, Kartika and I realized that language is important for transferring culture to the next generation. Every day, Kartika and I try our best with our children to speak only Tamil with them.

Tell us about your challenges and how did you overcome them?

I'm highly competitive, taking everything very seriously, and never viewing anything as a non-challenge. When people say something can't be done, I don't accept it. One of my senior colleague told me that I could either be a clinician or a researcher, but not both. I didn't agree, and I proved it by doing both. Then, when people said I couldn't balance animal science research and global health, I did both. At 4-5 years of my career, one of my colleagues told me I had done excellent work but that I would hit a glass ceiling very soon and couldn't become Chief of Neonatology for the next 15 years due to seniority and waiting periods. I proved him wrong and became the chief within 10 years of my neonatologist career. When people ask what's next after becoming an academic Chief Medical Officer, I say, "Let's see where the path takes me." Coming to the U.S. as a doctor was tough. I arrived on an F1 visa, then completed my master's and residency. There were hurdles at every step, but I kept pushing forward. The most difficult part was navigating the academic side of things when I first arrived in the U.S., but in the end, everything worked out.



Member Spotlight Continued

What do you value the most?

I value my family the most. To me, family comes first, friends and relatives second, and work is last.

What is your advice for a new comer?

I will always have a deep love for my home country, India, but I believe we should never take this country for granted, as it has given me everything. I advise enjoying every moment of life and not prioritizing work above all else. If you encounter constraints, view them as opportunities because they help to shape who you are. Failure often paves the way for your next step, so always look for the opportunity in each challenge. My key advice is to step out of your comfort zone. Without doing so, there can be no real growth. We all took a leap outside of our comfort zones when we left India. Always push yourself to face challenges, and you'll experience remarkable growth. I never set out to become a CMO, but things naturally fell into place.

How ATS community has evolved from your view?

ATS is often underrated. When I spoke with my daughter, she mentioned how she got so many opportunities in dancing and music through ATS. Now, she no longer fears performing on stage, which has given her a great boost in confidence. ATS has provided a fantastic platform for my kids to showcase all their talents. I'm incredibly proud that my children have developed such a strong cultural connection through ATS. The Tamil school, the Pongal celebrations, and other cultural events have been invaluable in helping them learn about their heritage. I'm truly grateful for ATS. Without it, I'm certain my kids wouldn't have had the same cultural exposure. I would do anything to support ATS

What is your vision on the future of our youth?

As a parent, my advice is to step back and allow your kids to make their own decisions. Kids are incredibly smart, and often, it's us, as parents, who are the ones feeling uncertain. Let them become whoever they want to be. I don't feel the need to advise the next generation because they are so intelligent I actually learn from them.

What are the positives in Birmingham?

As members, we should all contribute more and encourage our kids to get involved in various activities. We need to focus on community work and embrace our cultural values, allowing us to expand our reach. We have many people in our community doing great things. Now we have to develop pathways for our younger generation to get involve community work.

Tell us about your hobbies and interest outside your family and work.

I used to be a volleyball player and represented Tamil Nadu State Volleyball team three times. I was the captain for the Madras Medical College volleyball team for 4 years.

What is your message to ATS?

We need to establish a program to support underprivileged kids locally and globally, going beyond our cultural focus to secure funding for their future. We could develop a structure for our kids to get involved in community work. It's important to give younger kids real exposure of America by helping them to participate in local community and youth leadership opportunities.

Adhithi is an accomplished dancer and theatre artist.

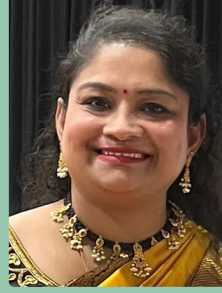

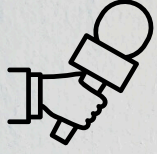
